- 1. Assemble Your Squad: Gather a group of volunteers to form your event committee, who will help plan and execute an amazing event.
- 2. Recruit Your Heat Heroes: Choose your participants! Will it be members of your senior leadership team, nominees from each department, or those who are willing to raise the most funds for Holland Bloorview?
- 3. Set a Fundraising Goal: Determine a target and set up individual or team fundraising pages. Your Holland Bloorview contact will help you get set up.
- **4. Spread the Word:** Promote your HB Heat Heroes event at work, encouraging employees to donate and support their colleagues.
- **5. Gather Your Supplies:** Use our comprehensive event kit to gather all the necessary supplies, from hot sauces to milk, and our branded capes! We're here to support and answer any questions.

- **6. Plan Your Event:** Choose a suitable space, create an event schedule, decide on layout and how you'll select the winner(s)!

TO ENSURE A SUCCESSFUL AND ENJOYABLE CHALLENGE, WE'VE PROVIDED A LIST OF ESSENTIAL ITEMS:

Food Items:

- ☐ Pre-cooked wings or wing alternatives (cauliflower bites)
- ☐ Assorted hot sauces purchase the official Hot Ones sauce kit or assemble your own lineup
- ☐ Milk or non-dairy alternative
- ☐ Cold water

Other Supplies:

- Wet wipes
- ☐ Paper towels/Kleenex
- ☐ Air fryer (optional if cooking wings onsite)
- ☐ Serving platters and utensils
- Cups
- ☐ Timer or stopwatch
- ☐ Microphone and speakers
- ☐ First aid kit

REMEMBER:

- Adjust the number of wings and hot sauce levels based on the time available and participant preferences.
- Ensure all participants are aware of the rules and safety guidelines.
- Create a fun and supportive atmosphere to encourage participation and maximize fundraising efforts.

With a bit of planning, your **HB Heat** Heroes Challenge will be a memorable and impactful event for everyone involved!







THE BEST WAY TO GUARANTEE DONATIONS IS TO GET YOUR LEADERSHIP INVOLVED! WHO WOULDN'T DONATE TO PUT THEIR BOSS IN THE HOT SEAT?

- 1. Get buy in from senior leadership to participate.
- 2. Agree on a fundraising goal for all participants.
- 3. Set up a corporate team and participant pages on CapesForKids.ca.
- 4. Send out a communication to employees outlining the event and how to donate.
- 5. Encourage participants to share their fundraising page broadly to maximize donations from their networks.
- 6. Post the team link on your company's social media to promote your participation.
- 7. Encourage any employees who would like to fundraise to set up their own page and earn a cape!

Tips on collecting employee donations:

- Use your company's existing giving platform (like Benevity).
- Collect donations in exchange for a ticket to attend the event.
- Collect donations in exchange for submitting interview questions for specific participants.









THIS GUIDE OUTLINES THE RECOMMENDED SETUP AND FLOW FOR YOUR HB HEAT HEROES EVENT, ENSURING A SMOOTH AND ENGAGING EXPERIENCE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS.

Room Setup:

- Arrange the room with a designated table at the front, allowing for clear visibility for the audience.
- Ensure comfortable seating for participants at the challenge table.
- Set up audience seating with a clear view of the challenge area.

Wing Preparation:

- Pre-cook wings in advance and reheat on the day of the event or Order wings and meat alternative 'wings' two hours before the event.
- Coat wings with the various hot sauces in increasing order of spiciness.
- Place wings with corresponding hot sauce in front of each participant. Create labels with the name of each hot sauce.
- Place prepared wings on plates along with necessary items: paper towels, glass of water, glass of milk, other items as needed (e.g., napkins, wet wipes).

Flow:

- Begin with a welcome and introduction, explaining the rules and format of the challenge.
- Play a fun video from us with honourary kid captains cheering you on.
- Proceed through the hot sauce levels, allowing participants ample time to consume each wing and answer questions.
- Incorporate breaks between levels to allow participants to cool down and rehydrate.
- Conclude with a celebration of all participants and recognition of the winner(s).

Additional Considerations:

- Prepare a slide show to enhance the event.
- Consider offering mild or non-spicy options for those who want to participate but can't handle the heat.
- Emphasize the fun and fundraising aspects of the event over extreme levels of spiciness.
- Highlight the connection to Holland Bloorview and the positive impact the event will have.
- Capture photos and videos of the event with participant and audience consent.

- Rapid fire questions Ask a series of simple questions, immediately after the participant has taken a bite. Examples –
 how many days of the week end in the letter Y, name a country that starts with P, etc.

Before we get started, let's establish some ground rules! Today, all our participants are winners – after all, they're doing this for a great cause! But, to make things more exciting, those of you who can get through all of the wings and questions without water, milk, or anything else to help you, will go home with all the GLORY!

Are you ready?? Let's get started with the first hot sauce and the first question (Describe hot sauce #1)

(Ask question #1)

Ok, we're just getting started here! The questions are going to keep coming, and the sauces are going to get even hotter! Onto the next:

(Describe hot sauce #2) (Ask question #2)





I think our participants are starting to feel the heat! Just a reminder to all of you that you're doing this for a great cause, and I'll be sharing how much we raised for Holland Bloorview at the end, so you can all feel great about doing this today! Ok, up next!

(Describe hot sauce #3) (Ask question #3)

We're getting close to the finish line! Let's give it up for our brave HB Heat Heroes to get them through the next one! (Describe hot sauce #4) (Ask question #4)

This is it! We've made it to the final, hottest wing and spiciest question! Let's see if they can make it through the last round. (Describe hot sauce #5) (Ask guestion #5)

Well, there you have it everyone! Our brave participants have made it through and are officially crowned this year's HB Heat Heroes! Now, while this was a whole lot of fun and entertainment, the most important thing that we accomplished here today, is that we raised a whole lot of money for a worthy cause. Before I announce the final total, I want to take a moment to thank everyone who helped put today together (name any volunteers). And of course, let's give it up again for these brave souls who got up here today and took one for the kids! And of course, to everyone who donated and supported!

Safety First:

- Participants should not have any known allergies or health conditions that could be aggravated by spicy food.
- Acknowledge the risks involved in consuming spicy food.
- First aid supplies and access to medical personnel should be readily available.

Food Handling and Preparation:

- Use proper food safety practices when preparing and serving the wings/bites.
- Clearly label the different levels of spiciness for each sauce.
- Provide adequate amounts of water, milk, or other cooling beverages.

If hot sauce gets into eyes:

- Don't rub: Resist the urge to rub your eyes, as this will only spread the hot sauce and worsen the burning sensation.
- Wash your hands thoroughly: Use soap and water to ensure no hot sauce residue remains on your hands.
